participating in the Summer Program at Boys & Girls Club please contact Rosa E. Rodriguez at 956.399.7501.

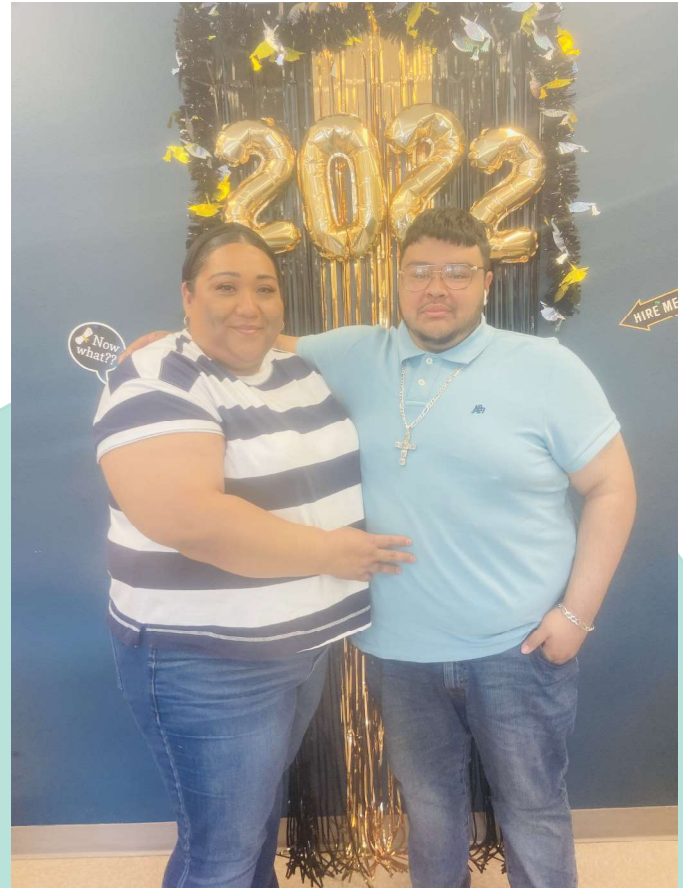

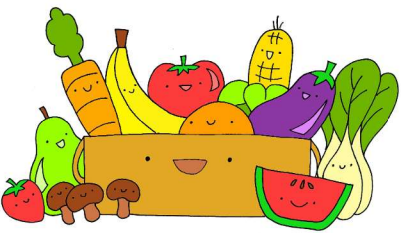

CALIFORNIA ROLL WRAPS

- 1/2 cup wasabi mayonnaise
- 6 whole wheat tortillas (8 inches)
- 2 packages (8oz ea.) imitation crab meat
- 1 medium ripe avocado, peeled and thinly sliced
- 1-1/2 cups julienned peeled jicama
- 1 medium sweet red pepper, julienned
- 1 small cucumber, seeded and julienned
- 3/4 cup bean sprouts

Directions

Divide the wasabi mayonnaise evenly among the 6 tortillas and spread to within 1/2 inch of edges. Layer with crabmeat, avocado, jicama, red pepper, cucumber and bean sprouts. Roll up tightly

Kitchen Tips

- If you can't find wasabi mayo, use regular mayo instead
- This sandwich lends itself to many flavor options. Toss in your favorite raw veggies, substitute smoked salmon or tuna for the crab and use half a pita instead of the tortilla

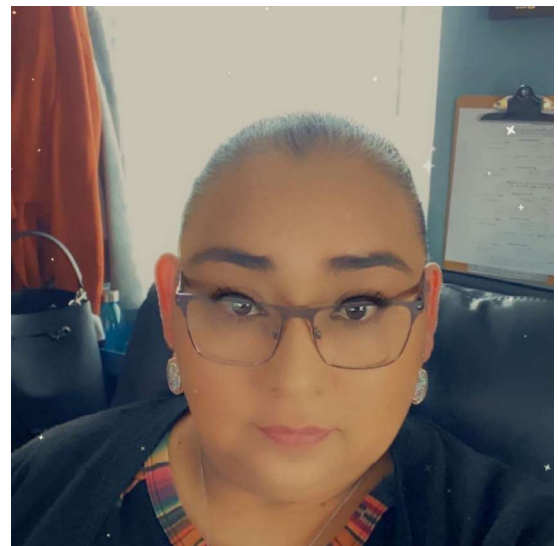

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

Palmville Homes

Originally constructed in the mid-1960's (Phase I) and early-1970's (Phase II), Palmville became the third and fourth public housing community of San Benito. Palmville was created to house the elderly community.

The SBHA had taken great care to choose a site, stating that, "It had to be a place not too crowded, close to different stores and shopping centers, a place that could be made to look like a community of apartment houses and not just like the other housing project."

Palmville received a 9% low-income housing tax credit award from Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs. Now the complete community will be remodeled from the inside out. Total renovation is expected by early fall of 2023.

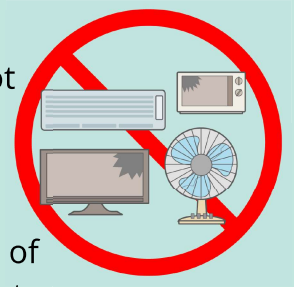

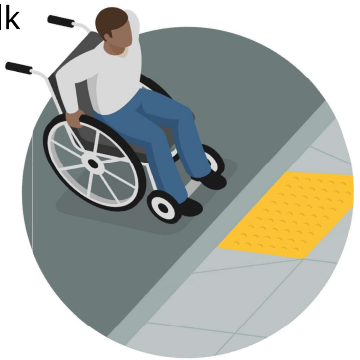
